The Seminary likewise supports other educational and formational programs to serve Byzantine Catholic Churches and the wider community.

Both degree programs are authorized by the Pennsylvania Department of Education, and both are fully accredited by The Association of Theological Schools.

The Master of Divinity degree (MDiv) prepares candidates for ordination to the priesthood, following the norms of the *Program of Priestly Formation* as they apply to the particular pastoral needs of Byzantine Catholic and other Eastern Churches in North America.

The Master of Arts in Byzantine Catholic Theology degree (MAT) prepares candidates to teach Byzantine Catholic theology in secondary schools and institutions of higher learning and provides a solid foundation for further research and study.
